AUSTRALIA: NOTIFICATION OF NOMINATION OF ARBITRATORS UNDER ARTICLE 2 OF  
 ANNEX VII OF THE CONVENTION

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary,  
 communicates the following:

On 19 August 1999, the Government of Australia notified the Secretary-General of the  
 following nomination of arbitrators for the purposes of article 2 of annex VII of the above Convention:

“Sir Gerard Brennan AC KBE, formerly a Judge of the High Court of Australia (1981-1998)  
 and Chief Justice of Australia (1995-1998), is a distinguished Australian lawyer with expertise in  
 international law;

Mr. Henry Burmester QC, Chief General Counsel for the Australian Government Solicitor, was  
 formerly Head of the Office of International Law in the Attorney-General's Department for a number of  
 years. He has significant expertise and qualifications in international law, particularly in the law of the  
 sea;

Professor Ivan Shearer AM, Challis Professor of International Law at Sydney University,  
 specialises in the law of the sea, on which he has published extensively, and is a member of the  
 Permanent Court of Arbitration in The Hague.

All of these nominees "enjoy the highest reputation for fairness, competence and integrity"  
 required by Article 2 (1) of Annex VII and have indicated their willingness to serve in the relevant  
 capacity.”
