

**10. g) Amendment to article 8 of the Rome Statute of the International Criminal Court (Intentionally using starvation of civilians)**

*The Hague, 6 December 2019*

**ENTRY INTO FORCE:** 14 October 2021 . The Amendment first entered into force on 14 October 2021 in regard to New Zealand one year after the deposit of its instrument of ratification, in accordance with article 121(5) of the Rome Statute.

**REGISTRATION:** 14 October 2021, No. 38544.
