# Treaty Event – Focus 2007: Towards Universal Participation and Implementation

# Daily Report Tuesday, 25 September 2007

11 States undertook 20 treaty actions today. Of that number, 6 States participated at the level of **Head of State or Government** and 5 States participated at the level of **Minister for Foreign Affairs**. There were a total of 17 signatures, and 3 ratifications. A breakdown of the actions by treaty appears below.

### **Human Rights**

- Optional Protocol to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, 1966 (1 signature by Kazakhstan).
- Optional Protocol to the Convention against Torture and Other Cruel, Inhuman or Degrading Treatment or Punishment, 2002 (1 signature by Kazakhstan).

## **Terrorism, Organized Crime and Corruption**

- United Nations Convention against Corruption, 2003 (1 ratification by Sweden).
- International Convention for the Suppression of Acts of Nuclear Terrorism, 2005 (1 ratification by Ukraine).

#### **Environmental**

• Stockholm Convention on Persistent Organic Pollutants, 2001 (1 ratification by Ukraine).

#### **International Trade**

• United Nations Convention on the Use of Electronic Communications in International Contracts, 2005 (2 signatures by Panama and the Philippines).

- Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities, 2006 (5 signatures by Estonia, Madagascar, Mauritius, the Philippines and Swaziland).
