Past Treaty Events

The Treaty Event was initiated as a side activity of the Millennium Summit in 2000. Each year, a focus is selected, highlighting a group of treaties, as a way to encourage Member States to sign, ratify or otherwise support these treaties. In 2001, an additional treaty event was held in the wake of 11 September to highlight terrorism-related treaties.

The following is a list of past treaty events and the number of actions taken by Member States:

- 2000 The Millennium Summit Treaty Event 274 treaty actions by 84 States
- 2001 Focus Rights of Women and Children 135 treaty actions by 61 States
 - Treaty Event Terrorism-related Treaties 180 treaty actions by 79 States
- 2002 Focus Sustainable Development 84 treaty actions by 41 States
- Focus Treaties against Transnational Organized Crime and Terrorism 155 treaty actions by 56 States
- Focus Treaties on the Protection of Civilians 102 treaty actions by 35 States
- 2005 Focus Responding to Global Challenges265 treaty actions by 99 States and the European Community
- 2006 Focus Crossing Borders86 treaty actions by 46 States
- Focus Towards Universal Participation and Implementation81 treaty actions by 48 States
- Focus Universal Participation and Implementation Dignity and Justice for All of Us 84 treaty actions by 44 States

Note: Treaty actions include, for example, signatures, ratifications, approvals, acceptances, accessions and consents to be bound. There have been a total of ten treaty events before the 2009 event and a total of 1,446 treaty actions have taken place.
