
2011 Treaty Event: Towards Universal Participation and Implementation

Daily Report

Tuesday, 27 September 2011

The Treaty Section today registered **eight (8) treaty actions** by **six (6)** Member States. **Five (5)** Member States participated at the **ministerial level**.

There were a total of one (1) ratification, one (1) acceptance, and six (6) signatures. A breakdown of the treaty actions is provided below:
