Today five (5) **treaty actions** were effected with the Secretary-General by four (4) States; one (1) State participated at the level of **Head of State** and two (2) States participated at the level of **Head of Government**.

There was a total of two (2) acceptances, one (1) accession, one (1) ratification, and one (1) signature. A breakdown of the treaty actions is provided below:
