## 2017 Treaty Event: Promoting Multilateral Treaties that Safeguard Humanity Daily Report

Tuesday 19 September 2017

Today ten (10) **treaty actions** were effected with the Secretary-General by five (5) States; one (1) State participated at the level of **Head of Government** and four (4) States participated at the **ministerial level**.
