2018 Treaty Event: Promotion of Human Rights through the Multilateral Treaty Framework Daily Report

Friday, 28 September 2018

Today eleven (11) **treaty actions** were effected with the Secretary-General by six (6) States; four (4) States participated at the **ministerial level** and two (2) States participated at the **ambassadorial level**.

There were a total of one (1) acceptance, nine (9) ratifications and one (1) signature. A breakdown of the treaty actions is provided below:
