
2022 Treaty Event: Promoting the International Treaty Framework Daily Report

Thursday, 22 September 2022

Today nine (9) **treaty actions** were effected with the Secretary-General by nine (9) States; eight (8) States participated at the **ministerial level** and one (1) State participated at **other level**.

There were a total of one (1) accession, three (3) ratifications and five (5) signatures. A breakdown of the treaty actions is provided below:

Human Rights

 Optional Protocol to the Convention on the Rights of the Child on a communications procedure (New York, 19 December 2011) (Accession by New Zealand)

International Trade and Development

• Agreement to establish the South Centre (Geneva, 1 September 1994) (Ratification by Colombia)

Disarmament

• Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons (New York, 7 July 2017) (Signature by Barbados, Burkina Faso, Equatorial Guinea, Haiti and Sierra Leone; Ratification by the Democratic Republic of the Congo and the Dominican Republic)
