
Sir,

I am directed by the Secretary-General to refer to letter C.N.35.1970.TREATIES-1 of 20 March 1970, informing you of the deposit of the instrument of accession by the Government of the Mongolian People's Republic to the Convention on the Privileges and Immunities of the Specialized Agencies, approved by the General Assembly of the United Nations on 21 November 1947, and of the reservation in respect of sections 24 and 32 of the Convention contained in that instrument.

I have the honour to inform you that, on 17 August 1970, the Secretary-General received the following communication from the Acting Permanent Representative of the United Kingdom to the United Nations with reference to the above-mentioned reservation:

"Her Majesty's Government wish to put on record that they are unable to accept these reservations because, in their view, they are not of the kind which intending parties to the Convention have the right to make."
