EUROPEAN AGREEMENT CONCERNING THE INTERNATIONAL CARRIAGE
OF DANGEROUS GOODS BY ROAD (ADR)
DONE AT GENEVA ON 30 SEPTEMBER 1957ACCEPTANCE OF THE AMENDMENTS PROPOSED TO THE REVISED TEXT OF
ANNEXES A AND B, AS AMENDED AND CORRECTED AS AT 31 JULY 1982

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, and referring to depositary notification C.N.178.1984.TREATIES-1 of 20 August 1984 transmitting certain amendments proposed to the revised text of annexes A and B of the above-mentioned Agreement, as amended and corrected as at 31 July 1982, communicates the following:

By 20 November 1984, i.e. within three months from the date of the above-mentioned depositary notification, no objection had been notified to the Secretary-General. Consequently, and in accordance with article 14 (3) the said amendments are deemed accepted and will enter into force on 1 May 1985, as decided by the Group of Experts at its thirty-seventh session.
