concerning modifications

CORRIGENDUM TO REGULATION No. 79

UNIFORM PROVISIONS CONCERNING THE APPROVAL OF VEHICLES  
WITH REGARD TO THE STEERING EQUIPMENT

(TRANS/SC1/WP29/246/Corr.1)

Paragraph 5.1.3., amend to read:

"... of those parts listed ..."

Paragraph 5.2.1.1., add to read:

"5.2.1.1. If the steering control is directly handled by  
the driver;

5.2.1.1.1. it must be manageable;

5.2.1.1.2. the direction of operation of the steering control  
must correspond to the intended change in direction  
of the vehicle;

5.2.1.1.3. except for ASE, there must be a continuous and  
monotonic relation between the steering control  
angle and the steering angle."

Paragraph 5.2.4.1.1., replace "6.2.5." by "6.2.6."
