Le Secrétaire général de l'Organisation des Nations Unies,
agissant en sa qualité de dépositaire, communique :

I

Le 30 octobre 1992, l'instrument d'adhésion par le Gouvernement géorgien à l'Acte constitutif susmentionné a été déposé auprès du Secrétaire général.

Conformément au paragraphe 2 c) de son article 25, l'Acte constitutif est entré en vigueur pour la Géorgie à la date du dépôt de son instrument, soit le 30 octobre 1992.

II

Le 3 décembre 1992, le Gouvernement canadien a déposé auprès du Secrétaire général un instrument de dénonciation dudit Acte constitutif. (A cet égard référence est faite à la notification dépositaire C.N.296.1983.TREATIES-13 du 30 septembre 1983 concernant la ratification par le Canada de l'Acte constitutif.)

Conformément au paragraphe 2 de son article 6, la dénonciation prendra effet le dernier jour de l'exercice financier suivant l'exercice au cours duquel ledit instrument a été déposé, soit le 31 décembre 1993.

13. The thirteenth part is a list of the authors and their affiliations, along with their contact information.

14. The fourteenth part is a declaration of the originality and integrity of the work, signed by the authors.

15. The fifteenth part is a certificate of approval from the relevant academic or professional body.

16. The sixteenth part is a list of the keywords and subject terms used to describe the content of the report.

17. The seventeenth part is a final review and approval of the report, signed by the supervisor or committee.

18. The eighteenth part is a list of the figures and tables included in the report, with their respective captions.

19. The nineteenth part is a list of the abbreviations and acronyms used throughout the document.
