REGULATION NO. 1. UNIFORM PROVISIONS CONCERNING THE  
APPROVAL OF MOTOR VEHICLE HEADLAMPS EMITTING AN  
ASYMMETRICAL PASSING BEAM AND/OR A DRIVING BEAM AND  
EQUIPPED WITH FILAMENT LAMPS OF CATEGORY R2 AND/OR HS1

ADOPTION OF THE AMENDMENTS PROPOSED TO REGULATION NO. 1  
ANNEXED TO THE AGREEMENT<sup>1</sup>

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary,  
communicates the following:

Within the period of six months following the date of depositary notification  
C.N.105.2001.TREATIES-2 of 8 March 2001, none of the Contracting Parties applying Regulation  
No.1 expressed disagreement with the proposed amendments. Therefore, in accordance with paragraph  
2 of article 12 of the Agreement, the proposed amendments are considered to be adopted and are  
binding upon all Contracting Parties applying Regulation No. 1 as of 8 September 2001, except for  
South Africa and Yugoslavia. Pursuant to article 12 (3) of the Agreement, the above amendments will  
enter into force for South Africa and Yugoslavia two months after the period of six months following  
the date of the notification by the Secretary-General of the proposed amendment, i.e., 8 November 2001.
