AGREEMENT CONCERNING THE ADOPTION OF UNIFORM TECHNICAL PRESCRIPTIONS FOR WHEELED VEHICLES, EQUIPMENT AND PARTS WHICH CAN BE FITTED AND/OR BE USED ON WHEELED VEHICLES AND THE CONDITIONS FOR RECIPROCAL RECOGNITION OF APPROVALS GRANTED ON THE BASIS OF THESE PRESCRIPTIONS.

**Within the period of six months following the date of depositary notification C.N.125.2001.TREATIES-1 of 12 March 2001, none of the Contracting Parties applying Regulation No. 101 expressed disagreement with the proposed amendments. Therefore, in accordance with paragraph 2 of article 12 of the Agreement, the proposed amendments are considered to be adopted and are binding upon all Contracting Parties applying Regulation No. 101 as of 12 September 2001.**
