ADOPTION OF AMENDMENTS TO REGULATION NO. 48¹

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary,
communicates the following:

Within the period of six months following the date of depositary notification
C.N.299.2006.TREATIES-1 of 10 April 2006 by which the Secretary-General transmitted to the
Contracting Parties a proposal of amendments to the above Regulation, one Contracting Party to the
Agreement notified its disagreement². Therefore, in accordance with paragraph 2 of article 12 of the
Agreement, the proposed amendments are considered to be adopted and are binding upon all
Contracting Parties applying Regulation No. 48, except Bosnia and Herzegovina, as of 10 October
2006.
