REGULATION NO. 124. UNIFORM PROVISIONS CONCERNING THE
APPROVAL OF WHEELS FOR PASSENGER CARS

ENTRY INTO FORCE OF REGULATION NO. 124¹

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary,
communicates the following:

Within the period of six months from the date of depositary notification
C.N.595.2006.TREATIES-4 of 2 August 2006 by which the Secretary-General transmitted to the
Governments of the Contracting Parties a copy of the above regulation, three Contracting Parties² to the
Agreement notified their disagreement with the draft Regulation. Therefore, in accordance with article
1(3) of the Agreement, the draft Regulation has been adopted as Regulation No. 124 annexed to the
above Agreement. The date of entry into force for all Contracting Parties, except Thailand, Japan and
Australia, is 2 February 2007, pursuant to article 1(4) of the Agreement.
