ENTRY INTO FORCE OF THE PROTOCOL¹

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

Within the period of six months following the notification by the Secretary-General of the adoption of the Protocol (depositary notification C.N.1103.2007.TREATIES-1 of 29 November 2007), none of the member States of the International Centre for Genetic Engineering and Biotechnology objected to the Protocol. Therefore, in accordance with its paragraph 2, the Protocol is considered accepted and entered into force automatically for all Parties to the Statutes on 29 May 2008.
