ACCEPTANCE OF THE AMENDMENTS PROPOSED BY PORTUGAL  
TO ANNEXES A AND B, AS AMENDED<sup>1</sup>

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary,  
communicates the following:

By 1 October 2008, i.e., on the expiry of the period of three months from the date of the depositary notification C.N.461.2008.TREATIES-1 of 1 July 2008, transmitting the text of the amendments proposed by the Government of Portugal to Annexes A and B, as amended, no objection had been notified to the Secretary-General. Consequently, and in accordance with article 14 (3) of the Agreement, the amendments are deemed accepted and will enter into force for all the Contracting Parties on the date proposed, i.e., on 1 January 2009.
