ENTRY INTO FORCE OF AMENDMENTS TO THE REGULATIONS ANNEXED TO THE ADN<sup>1</sup>

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

By 30 November 2008, none of the Contracting Parties to the above-mentioned Agreement had communicated an objection to the Secretary-General. Consequently, in accordance with the provisions of article 20 (5) of the Agreement, the amendments will enter into force for all the Contracting Parties on the expiry of a further period of three months, i.e., on 28 February 2009.
