REGULATION NO. 101. UNIFORM PROVISIONS CONCERNING THE  
APPROVAL OF PASSENGER CARS POWERED BY AN INTERNAL  
COMBUSTION ENGINE ONLY, OR POWERED BY A HYBRID ELECTRIC  
POWER TRAIN WITH REGARD TO THE MEASUREMENT OF THE EMISSION  
OF CARBON DIOXIDE AND FUEL CONSUMPTION AND/OR THE  
MEASUREMENT OF ELECTRIC ENERGY CONSUMPTION AND ELECTRIC  
RANGE, AND OF CATEGORIES M1 AND N1 VEHICLES POWERED BY AN  
ELECTRIC POWER TRAIN ONLY WITH REGARD TO THE MEASUREMENT  
OF ELECTRIC ENERGY CONSUMPTION AND ELECTRIC RANGE

ADOPTION OF AMENDMENTS TO REGULATION NO. 101<sup>1</sup>

Within the period of six months following the date of depositary notification  
C.N.38.2009.TREATIES-1 of 22 January 2009, none of the Contracting Parties applying Regulation  
No. 101 expressed disagreement with the proposed amendments. Therefore, in accordance with  
paragraph 2 of article 12 of the Agreement, the proposed amendments are considered to be adopted and  
are binding upon all Contracting Parties applying Regulation No. 101 as of 22 July 2009.
