BANGKOK, 18 NOVEMBER 2003

ACCEPTANCE OF AMENDMENTS TO ANNEX I OF THE AGREEMENT¹

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary and with reference to depositary notification C.N.732.2009.TREATIES-2 of 14 October 2009 concerning the amendments proposed by China, India and Kazakhstan to Annex 1 of the above Agreement, communicates the following:

Within the period of six months following the date of the above depositary notification, none of the Contracting Parties to the Agreement expressed an objection. Therefore, in accordance with paragraph 5 of article 9, the proposed amendments are deemed to be accepted.

Pursuant to the provisions of paragraph 6 of article 9, the amendments to the Agreement will enter into force for all Contracting Parties three (3) months after the date of this notification, i.e., on 15 July 2010.
