The ADN Administrative Committee has drawn the attention of the Secretary-General to certain errors in the English and French texts of the 2009 version of the Regulations annexed to ADN and requested that the corresponding corrections be transmitted to Contracting Parties so that they become effective at the latest by 1 January 2011 (ECE/ADN/11, para. 11 (b)).

The texts of the proposed corrections are contained in Annex II of the report of the ADN Safety Committee of the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe on its session of 23 to 26 August 2010 (ECE/TRANS/WP.15/AC.2/36).
