ADOPTION OF AMENDMENTS TO REGULATION NO. 100¹

C.N.856.2011.TREATIES-2 of 26 January 2012, none of the Contracting Parties applying Regulation
No. 100 expressed disagreement with the proposed amendments. Therefore, in accordance with
paragraph 2 of article 12 of the Agreement, the proposed amendments are considered to be adopted and
are binding upon all Contracting Parties applying Regulation No. 100 as of 26 July 2012.
