AGREEMENT CONCERNING THE ADOPTION OF UNIFORM TECHNICAL
PRESCRIPTIONS FOR WHEELED VEHICLES, EQUIPMENT AND PARTS
WHICH CAN BE FITTED AND/OR BE USED ON WHEELED VEHICLES AND
THE CONDITIONS FOR RECIPROCAL RECOGNITION OF APPROVALS
GRANTED ON THE BASIS OF THESE PRESCRIPTIONS

JAPAN: NOTIFICATION OF DISAGREEMENT UNDER ARTICLE 1 (2) OF THE AGREEMENT¹

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary,
communicates the following:

Within the period of six months from the date of depositary notification
C.N.221.2012.TREATIES-1 of 17 May 2012 by which the Secretary-General transmitted to the
Governments of the Contracting Parties a copy of the following Draft Regulation:

“Uniform provisions concerning the approval of light emitting diode (LED) light sources for
use in approved lamp units on power-driven vehicles and their trailers”,

the Government of Japan notified, on 13 November 2012, its disagreement with the said draft
Regulation. Therefore, in accordance with article 1 (4) of the Agreement, the above-mentioned
Regulation will not enter into force for Japan on the date of its adoption.
