Within the period of six months from the date of depositary notification C.N.221.2012.TREATIES-1 of 17 May 2012 by which the Secretary-General transmitted to the Governments of the Contracting Parties a copy of the following Draft Regulation:

"Uniform provisions concerning the approval of light emitting diode (LED) light sources for use in approved lamp units on power-driven vehicles and their trailers",

the Government of Japan notified, on 13 November 2012, its disagreement with the said draft Regulation. Therefore, in accordance with article 1 (4) of the Agreement, the above-mentioned Regulation will not enter into force for Japan on the date of its adoption.
