REGULATION NO. 97. UNIFORM PROVISIONS CONCERNING THE

ADOPTION OF AMENDMENTS TO REGULATION NO. 97¹

Within the period of six months following the date of depositary notification
C.N.55.2013.TREATIES-XI.B.16.97 of 15 January 2013, none of the Contracting Parties applying
Regulation No. 97 expressed disagreement with the proposed amendments. Therefore, in accordance
with paragraph 2 of article 12 of the Agreement, the proposed amendments are considered to be adopted
and are binding upon all Contracting Parties applying Regulation No. 97 as of 15 July 2013.
