EUROPEAN AGREEMENT CONCERNING THE WORK OF CREWS OF  
VEHICLES ENGAGED IN INTERNATIONAL ROAD TRANSPORT (AETR)

GENEVA, 1 JULY 1970

NETHERLANDS: COMMUNICATION PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 21 (5) (B)  
OF THE AGREEMENT

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary,  
communicates the following:

On 5 April 2016, following its communication pursuant to article 21 (2) (b)<sup>1</sup>, the Government of the Kingdom of the Netherlands notified the Secretary-General that, in accordance with article 21 (5) (b) of the Agreement, the Kingdom of the Netherlands, for the European part of the Netherlands, has met the necessary constitutional requirements for acceptance of the proposed amendment transmitted by C.N.136.2015.TREATIES-XI.B.21 of 18 February 2015.

It will be recalled that the Kingdom of the Netherlands was the only Contracting Party to have sent a communication pursuant to article 21 (2) (b). As a result, the proposed amendment is deemed to be accepted and will enter into force on 5 July 2016<sup>2</sup>.
