AGREEMENT CONCERNING THE ADOPTION OF UNIFORM TECHNICAL  
PRESCRIPTIONS FOR WHEELED VEHICLES, EQUIPMENT AND PARTS  
WHICH CAN BE FITTED AND/OR BE USED ON WHEELED VEHICLES AND  
THE CONDITIONS FOR RECIPROCAL RECOGNITION OF APPROVALS  
GRANTED ON THE BASIS OF THESE PRESCRIPTIONS

AUSTRALIA: NOTIFICATION OF DISAGREEMENT UNDER ARTICLES 1 (2) AND (4)  
OF THE AGREEMENT<sup>1</sup>

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary,  
communicates the following:

Within the period of six months from the date of depositary notification  
C.N.919.2016.TREATIES-XI.B.16 of 19 December 2016, by which the Secretary-General transmitted  
to the Governments of the Contracting Parties a copy of the Draft Regulation entitled “Uniform  
provisions concerning the approval of Heavy Duty Dual-Fuel Engine Retrofit Systems (HDDF-ERS) to  
be installed on heavy duty diesel engines and vehicles”, the Government of Australia notified, on  
8 June 2017, its disagreement with the said draft Regulation.

Therefore, in accordance with article 1 (4) of the Agreement, the above-mentioned Regulation  
will not enter into force for Australia in the event of its adoption.
