The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary, communicates the following:

On 30 November 2018, the Secretary-General received from the Administrative Committee of the above Agreement, pursuant to article 2 (1) of the Agreement, the following draft Rule:

"Periodical Technical Inspections of motor vehicles using Compressed Natural Gas (CNG), Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG) and/or Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) in their propulsion system".

Reference is made in this respect to article 2 (2) and (3) of the Agreement, which read as follows:

- "2. When a Rule has been adopted the Secretary-General shall so notify as soon as possible all the Contracting Parties, specifying which Contracting Parties have objected and in respect of which the Rule shall not enter into force.
- 3. The adopted Rule shall enter into force on the date(s) specified therein as a Rule annexed to this Agreement for all Contracting Parties which did not notify their disagreement."
