EUROPEAN AGREEMENT CONCERNING THE WORK OF CREWS OF  
VEHICLES ENGAGED IN INTERNATIONAL ROAD TRANSPORT (AETR)

GENEVA, 1 JULY 1970

NETHERLANDS: COMMUNICATION PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 21(5)(b)  
OF THE AGREEMENT

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary,  
communicates the following:

On 8 October 2019, following its communication pursuant to article 21 (2) (b)<sup>1</sup>, the Government of the Kingdom of the Netherlands notified the Secretary-General that, in accordance with article 21 (5) (b) of the AETR, the Kingdom of the Netherlands, for the European part of the Netherlands, had met the necessary constitutional requirements for acceptance of the proposed amendment to article 14 of the AETR transmitted by C.N.561.2018.TREATIES-XI.B.21 of 16 November 2018.

It will be recalled that the Kingdom of the Netherlands was the only Party to have sent a communication to the Depositary pursuant to article 21 (2) (b). As a result, the proposed amendment is deemed accepted and shall enter into force on 8 January 2020<sup>2</sup>.
