No. 14604. AGREEMENT FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A REGIONAL ANIMAL PRODUCTION AND HEALTH COMMISSION FOR ASIA, THE FAR EAST AND THE SOUTH-WEST PACIFIC. CONCLUDED AT ROME ON 22 JUNE 1973¹

MODIFICATION of the title and of articles I and V of the above-mentioned Agreement, as amended

By resolution 3/90 the Council of the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations, on 28 November 1986 at its ninetieth session held at Rome, approved amendments to the abovementioned title and articles of the Agreement as amended on 8 November 1979.

The said amendments, not involving new obligations for the members of the Commission, took effect on 28 November 1986, the date of their approval by the Council of the Organization, in accordance with article XVII (4) of the Agreement.

Title of the Agreement

Agreement for the Establishment of a Regional Animal Production and Health Commission for Asia [, the Far East] and the [South-West] Pacific*

Article I. ESTABLISHMENT OF THE COMMISSION

The Contracting Parties, realizing the need to coordinate their policies, plans and programmes in livestock production, and disease control and eradication, and desiring to provide machinery for the exchange of information and experience, hereby establish, within the framework of the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (hereinafter referred to as "the Organization"), a Commission to be known as the "Regional Animal Production and Health Commission for Asia [, the Far East] and the [South-West] Pacific (hereinafter referred to as "the Commission").*

Article V. SEAT OF THE COMMISSION

1. The Seat of the Commission shall be the FAO Regional Office for Asia and the [Far East] Pacific, Bangkok, Thailand.*
