***2016 Treaty Event:
Towards the promotion of the international legal framework on human
mobility***

Daily Report

Monday, 19 September 2016

Today seven (7) **treaty actions** were effected with the Secretary-General by five (5) States; two (2) States participated at the level of **Head of State**, one (1) State participated at the level of **Head of Government** and one (1) State participated at the **ministerial level**.

There were a total of three (3) accessions, three (3) ratifications, and one (1) signature. A breakdown of the treaty actions is provided below:

- **European Agreement concerning the International Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road (ADR) (Geneva, 30 September 1957)**
(Ratification by Georgia)

Penal Matters

- **United Nations Convention against Corruption (New York, 31 October 2003)**
(Accession by Holy See)

Environment

- **Paris Agreement (Paris, 12 December 2015)**
(Signature by Togo; Ratification by Ukraine)
