NOTIFICATION BY THE UNITED KINGDOM

Sir,

I am directed by the Secretary-General to inform you that the Government of the United Kingdom has notified him that the distinctive letters - CNB - have been selected for North Borneo (including Labuan) as the distinguishing sign of the place of registration of vehicles in international traffic, in accordance with paragraph 3 of Annex 4 of the Convention on Road Traffic signed at Geneva on 19 September 1949. These letters will replace the letters - SS - previously allotted to Labuan.

The present notification is made in accordance with alinea (m) of paragraph 1 of article 35 of the Convention.
