NOTIFICATION BY THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND

I am directed by the Secretary-General to inform you that the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland has notified him that the distinctive letters - BDS - have been selected for Barbados as the distinguishing sign of the place of registration of vehicles in international traffic, in accordance with paragraph 3 of Annex 4 of the Convention on Road Traffic signed at Geneva on 19 September 1949.

The present notification is made in accordance with sub-paragraph (m) of paragraph 1 of article 35 of the Convention.
