NOTIFICATIONS OF GOVERNMENTS

Sir,

I am directed by the Secretary-General to refer to the Convention on Road Traffic, signed at Geneva on 19 September 1949, and particularly to Annex 4 to the Convention containing the list of distinctive letters selected for States and territories as the distinguishing sign of the place of registration of motor vehicles in international traffic. This list was established at the United Nations Conference on Road and Motor Transport held at Geneva from 23 August to 19 September 1949.
