COMMUNICATION FROM THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND

Sir,

I am directed by the Secretary-General to refer to the letter C.N.99.1955.TREATIES of 27 October 1955, relating to the notifications of the distinctive letters which have been selected as the distinguishing sign of the place of registration of motor vehicles in international traffic.

In the annex to the above-mentioned letter I communicated to you the distinctive letters which had been notified to the Secretary-General from 14 April 1955 to 27 October 1955, and among them the distinctive letters - FM - selected by the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland for the Federation of Malaya as follows:

I have the honour to inform you that by a communication received on 9 March 1956, the Permanent Representative of the United Kingdom to the United Nations has notified the Secretary-General that his previous notification in this regard was incomplete and that the full list under the heading of Federation of Malaya, for which the distinctive letters - FM - have been selected, is as follows:

"The nine Malay States of Johore, Kedah, Kelantan, Negri Sembilan, Pahang, Perak, Perlis, Selangor and Trengganu, and the two British Settlements of Panang (with Province Wellesley) and Malacca".
