
COMMUNICATION BY THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND

Sir,

I am directed by the Secretary-General to refer to the letter C.N.77.1956.TREATIES of 9 August 1956, and to transmit to you the following extract from a communication of the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland relating to the reservation made in the instrument of accession of the Government of the Hungarian People's Republic to the Convention on the Privileges and Immunities of the United Nations:

" ... Her Majesty's Government regret that they are unable to accept the above-mentioned reservation because in their view it is not of the kind which intending parties of the Convention have the right to make.

Accept, Sir, the assurances of my highest consideration.
