AGREEMENT CONCERNING THE ADOPTION OF UNIFORM CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL AND
RECIPROCAL RECOGNITION OF APPROVAL FOR MOTOR VEHICLE EQUIPMENT AND
PARTS, DONE AT GENEVA ON 20 MARCH 1958

ACCESSION BY BELGIUM

Sir,

I am directed by the Secretary-General to inform you that, on 7 July 1959, the instrument of accession by the Government of Belgium to the Agreement concerning the Adoption of Uniform Conditions of Approval and Reciprocal Recognition of Approval for Motor Vehicle Equipment and Parts, done at Geneva on 20 March 1958, was deposited with the Secretary-General in accordance with paragraph 4 of article 6 of the Agreement.


The Government of Belgium made the following declarations at the time of deposit of the instrument of accession:

(Translation) (a) In accordance with article 1, paragraph 6, Belgium declares that it is not bound by any of the Regulations annexed to the Agreement;

(b) In accordance with article 11, paragraph 1, Belgium declares that it does not consider itself bound by article 10 of the Agreement.

In accordance with paragraph 2 of article 7 the Agreement will enter into force for Belgium on 5 September 1959, that is to say, on the sixtieth day after the deposit of the instrument of accession.
