NOTIFICATION BY THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND


Sir,

I am directed by the Secretary-General to inform you that the Permanent Representative of the United Kingdom to the United Nations, referring to paragraph 3 of Annex 4 of the Convention on Road Traffic, has notified him of the following changes in distinctive letters to be used by Northern Rhodesia, Nyasaland and Southern Rhodesia as the distinguishing sign of the place of registration of vehicles in international traffic.

- "(a) The distinctive letter for Northern Rhodesia, shown as NR, shall be replaced by the letters RNR;
- "(b) The distinctive letters for Nyasaland, shown as NP, shall be replaced by the letters RNY; and
- "(c) The distinctive letters for Southern Rhodesia, shown as SR, shall be replaced by the letters RSR."

The present notification is made in accordance with sub-paragraph (m) of paragraph 1 of article 35 of the Convention.
