CONVENTION ON ROAD TRAFFIC, DONE AT GENEVA ON 19 SEPTEMBER 1949 ACCESSION BY THE CONGO (BRAZZAVILLE)

Sir,

I am directed by the Secretary-General to inform you that, on 15 May 1962, the instrument of accession by the Government of the Congo to the Convention on Road Traffic, done at Geneva on 19 September 1949, was deposited with the Secretary-General in accordance with article 27.

In accordance with article 29, the Convention will enter into force for the Congo on the thirtieth day after the deposit of its instrument of accession, that is to say, on 14 June 1962.

Furthermore, I have the honour to inform you that the Government of the Congo has notified the Secretary-General that the distinctive letters - RCB - have been selected for the Congo as the distinguishing sign of the place of registration of vehicles in international traffic, in accordance with paragraph 3 of Annex 4 to the above-mentioned Convention.
