NOTIFICATION BY MADAGASCAR


Sir,

I am directed by the Secretary-General to inform you that, by a communication received on 27 June 1962, the Government of Madagascar notified the Secretary-General that it considers itself bound by the Convention on Road Traffic, done at Geneva on 19 September 1949, the application of which had been extended to its territory before the attainment of independence.

Furthermore, I have the honour to inform you that the Government of Madagascar has notified the Secretary-General that the distinctive letters - RM - have been selected for Madagascar as the distinguishing sign of the place of registration of vehicles in international traffic, in accordance with paragraph 3 of Annex 4 to the above-mentioned Convention.
