ACCESSION BY ECUADOR


Sir,

I am directed by the Secretary-General to inform you that, on 26 September 1962, the instrument of accession by the Government of Ecuador to the Convention on Road Traffic, done at Geneva on 19 September 1949, was deposited with the Secretary-General in accordance with article 27.

In accordance with article 29, the Convention will enter into force for Ecuador on the thirtieth day after the deposit of its instrument of accession, that is to say, on 26 October 1962.

Furthermore, I have the honour to inform you that the Government of Ecuador has notified the Secretary-General that the distinctive letters - EC - have been selected for Ecuador as the distinguishing sign of the place of registration of vehicles in international traffic, in accordance with paragraph 3 of Annex 4 to the above-mentioned Convention.
