
NOTIFICATION BY TOGO

Sir,

I am directed by the Secretary-General to refer to letter C.N.201.1962.TREATIES-15 of 27 September 1962, relating to the notification by the Government of Togo by which it considers itself bound by the Convention on Road Traffic, done at Geneva on 19 September 1949.

I have the honour to inform you that, by a communication received on 30 October 1962, the Government of Togo has notified the Secretary-General that the distinctive letters - TG - have been selected for Togo as the distinguishing sign of the place of registration of vehicles in international traffic, in accordance with paragraph 3 of Annex 4 to the above-mentioned Convention.
