ACCESSION BY ALGERIA


Sir,

I am directed by the Secretary-General to inform you that, on 16 May 1963, the instrument of accession by the Government of Algeria to the Convention on Road Traffic, done at Geneva on 19 September 1949, was deposited with the Secretary-General in accordance with article 27.

In accordance with article 29, the Convention will enter into force for Algeria on the thirtieth day after the deposit of its instrument of accession, that is to say, on 15 June 1963.

Furthermore, I have the honour to inform you that the Government of Algeria has notified the Secretary-General that the distinctive letters - DZ - have been selected for Algeria as the distinguishing sign of the place of registration of vehicles in international traffic, in accordance with paragraph 3 of Annex 4 to the above-mentioned Convention.

Accept, Sir, the assurances of my highest consideration.
