NOTIFICATION BY MALI

Sir,

I am directed by the Secretary-General to refer to letter C.N.292.1962.TREATIES-23 of 11 December 1962, relating to the notification by the Government of Mali by which it considers itself bound by the Convention on Road Traffic, done at Geneva on 19 September 1949.

I have the honour to inform you that, by a communication received on 24 June 1963, the Government of Mali has notified the Secretary-General that the distinctive letters - RMM - have been selected for Mali as the distinguishing sign of the place of registration of vehicles in international traffic, in accordance with paragraph 3 of Annex 4 to the above-mentioned Convention.
