CONVENTION ON ROAD TRAFFIC, DONE AT GENEVA ON 19 SEPTEMBER 1949

NOTIFICATION BY RWANDA

Sir,

I am directed by the Secretary-General to inform you that, by a communication received on 5 August 1964, the Government of Rwanda has notified the Secretary-General that it considers itself bound by the Convention on Road Traffic, done at Geneva on 19 September 1949, the application of which had been extended to its territory before the attainment of independence.

Furthermore, I have the honour to inform you that the Government of Rwanda has notified the Secretary-General that the distinctive letters - RWA - have been selected for Rwanda as the distinguishing sign of the place of registration of vehicles in international traffic, in accordance with paragraph 3 of Annex 4 to the above-mentioned Convention.

Accept, Sir, the assurances of my highest consideration.
