NOTIFICATION BY TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO


Sir,

I am directed by the Secretary-General to refer to letter C.N.118.1964.TREATIES-3 of 21 July 1964, relating to the deposit of the instrument of accession by the Government of Trinidad and Tobago to the Convention on Road Traffic, done at Geneva on 19 September 1949.

I have the honour to inform you that, by a communication received on 11 September 1964, the Government of Trinidad and Tobago has notified the Secretary-General that the distinctive letters - TT - have been selected for Trinidad and Tobago as the distinguishing sign of the place of registration of vehicles in international traffic, in accordance with paragraph 3 of Annex 4 to the above-mentioned Convention.
