
Sir,

I am directed by the Secretary-General to inform you that, on the dates indicated below, the Governments of the following States have signed the Convention on Special Missions, opened for signature at New York on 16 December 1969:

Philippines	16 December 1969
Argentina	18 December 1969
Jamaica	18 December 1969
Yugoslavia	18 December 1969

The Governments of the Philippines and Yugoslavia also signed, on the same dates as the Convention, the Optional Protocol concerning the Compulsory Settlement of Disputes, opened for signature at New York on 16 December 1969.
