AGREEMENT CONCERNING THE ADOPTION OF UNIFORM CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL AND  
RECIPROCAL RECOGNITION OF APPROVAL FOR MOTOR VEHICLE EQUIPMENT AND PARTS  
DONE AT GENEVA ON 20 MARCH 1958

ACCESSION BY AUSTRIA

Sir,

I am directed by the Secretary-General to inform you that, on 12 March 1971, the instrument of accession by the Government of Austria to the Agreement concerning the Adoption of Uniform Conditions of Approval and Reciprocal Recognition of Approval for Motor Vehicle Equipment and Parts, done at Geneva on 20 March 1958, was deposited with the Secretary-General, in accordance with article 6, paragraph 4.

In accordance with article 7(2) the Agreement will enter into force for Austria on the sixtieth day after the deposit of the above-mentioned instrument, that is to say, on 11 May 1971.

The accession was made subject to the following declaration:

"The Federal President of the Republic of Austria declares in accordance with article 1, paragraph 6, of the Agreement concerning the Adoption of Uniform Conditions of Approval and Reciprocal Recognition of Approval for Motor Vehicle Equipment and Parts that the accession of the Republic of Austria covers only the Agreement itself. The Republic of Austria is therefore not bound by any of the Regulations annexed to the Agreement."
